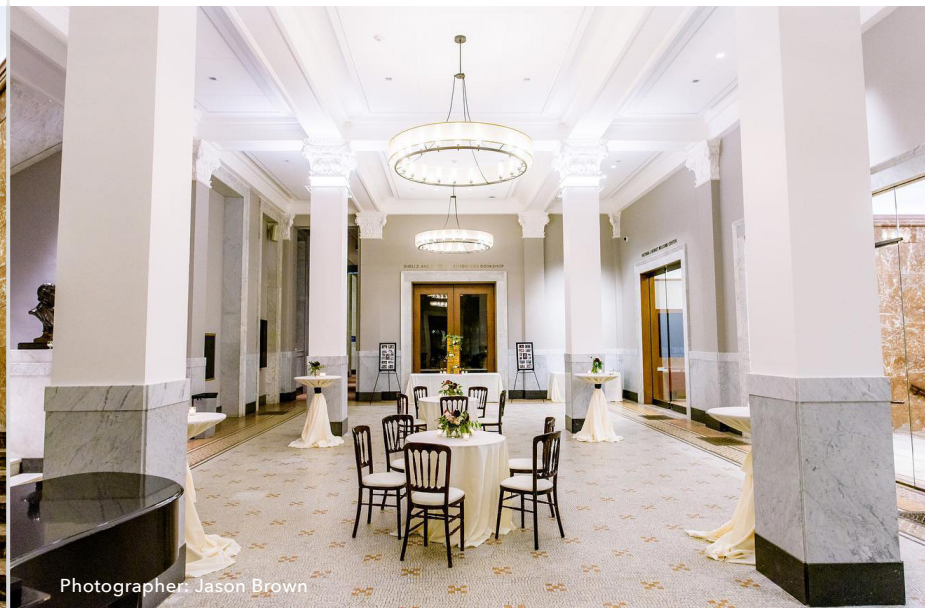

Designed by architect Henry Ives Cobb, the Newberry was completed in the autumn of 1893. The building has gone through several renovations, the last of which was completed in 2018.
